Fannin County Children's Center To Host April 21 *Network Nites*

The Fannin County Children's Center will be hosting their Network Nites on Thursday, April 21 from 5:30 – 7:00 p.m. at 112 West Fifth Street in Bonham.

Chamber members and the community are invited to join the event which is designed to celebrate multiple occasions. "We will be celebrating *Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention Month* which is in April and *National Crime Victims Rights Week* which is April 17-23," said Sandy Barber of the Children's Center. "We will give away special blue buttons and bracelets to our guests as a visible reminder of this."



The event will also be a celebration of artwork done by local children and youth for the "Open Your Heart" art contest. The winners of this annual contest will be recognized. Tours, refreshments and networking opportunities will also be a part of the event.

The mission of the Children's Center is to protect and enhance the quality of life of the abused, neglected and needy children of Fannin County. The Center operates several programs in

pursuit of this mission, including:

◆ **CASA**, which stands for Court Appointed Special Advocates, recruits, screens, trains and supervises volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children involved in the court system. In our most recent fiscal year, CASA served 63 children.

◆ **Children's Advocacy Center** provides a neutral, child-friendly agency that facilitates a multi-disciplinary team approach in the detection, investigation and treatment of child abuse to bring the offenders to justice and promote peace and healing for the victims. CAC opened 116 new cases last year.

◆ **Rainbow Rooms** are two emergency resource rooms operated in conjunction with CPS. They are stocked with community donations of new clothing, diapers, shoes, hygiene items and other supplies for the abused and neglected children served by CPS, CASA and/or CAC.

◆ **School Supply Drive** provided free school supplies to 669 students of Fannin County in 2010 thanks to community donations.

◆ **Christmas Drive** utilizes community donations to ensure that each child involved with CASA and/or CAC receives Christmas presents of new clothes and toys. In 2010, 129 children received gifts.

◆ **Child Abuse Prevention** programs are presented to children at area schools and day cares and to adults at the center and in the community in order to prevent children from being abused and knowing how to respond if abuse does happen.

There will also be some great opportunities to promote your business to all these players in a great atmosphere.

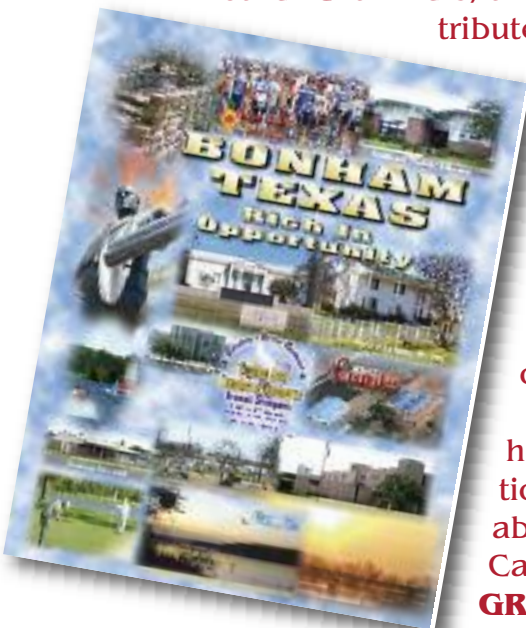

INQUIRY REPORT

During the month of March the Bonham Area Chamber of Commerce has professionally handled 358 Inquiry Calls, 163 Administrative Calls, and 233 Walk-ins. We sent out 15 Tourism Packets, 15 Relocation Packets, and 2 Demographics. We also handled 147 calls about Special Events. The total number of referrals from the Chamber's website business directory this period was 1,986 and each day there was an average of 55 referrals from the Chamber's Website directory.

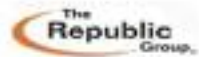
