The chamber also had two renewals last month. Bob Utter Ford and Texas Firearms Academy renewed their 2014 memberships.

Ribbon Cuttings were held for The Breakfast Stop and Dalnor Systems Inc.

Wayne and Brenda Moore, the owners of The Breakfast Stop are highlighted on page 4 of the newsletter this month.

Dalnor Systems Inc. is building a new structure on the city airport property that

will house a manufacturing facility that builds stands for aircraft engines. The company will start out with eight employees and expects to expand in the near future.

The Small Business Committee of the BEST/FEST group held a Risk Management Seminar at Bonham City Hall on June 27 and was attended by 20 business owners and individuals from throughout the county. John Farris with Farm n' Home Casualty talked about some of the risks involved in running a business today and how a business owner can work to alleviate risks. Risks to a business can be from weather, employees, customers, or areas even outside the owners control. By assessing the risks that could occur and planning for them upfront, the chance of a business surviving a significant risk claim can be greatly increased.

Youngest Flyer

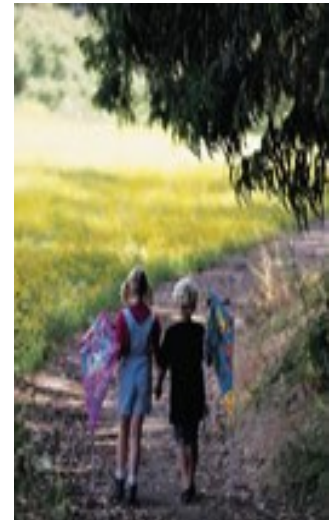
Most unique kite

BEST/FEST Meeting on June 19, 2014

The 2nd Quarter BEST/FEST meeting held on June 19, 2014 was attended by almost 70 people from around the Fannin County area. The BEST (Bonham Empowerment Support Team) and the FEST (Fannin county empowerment Support Team) were put together in 2013 to promote Bonham and Fannin County in retaining and attracting new businesses, attracting tourism dollars through eco-tourism, attracting retirees to move to the area, and a lakes committee to attract people to the two new lakes going into the county in the next few years.

Ron McCarthy, Permit Director for North Texas Municipal Water District gave an update on the status of Lower Bois d'arc in regards to their permits. Currently, the Water District is expecting to get both their TCEQ permit USACE permit by the end of 2015. At that time construction on the Lake could begin. Mr. McCarthy also talked about the regulations due to invasive species that affect lakes now and some of the ways to deal with them.

Tom Taylor, Executive Director of the Upper Trinity Water District gave an update on the status of Lake Ralph Hall. The lake has been approved by the TCEQ and currently the district is waiting on the USACE 404 permit to build the dam. Mr. Taylor informed the audience that the Lake Ralph Hall permit issued by the TCEQ was the first in almost 30 years for a large lake in the State of Texas.

Judge Laurie Blake, head of the Eco-Tourism Committee updated the audience on the groups work in getting a public access point to the Red River when a new bridge at Hwy 78 is built in the next few years. By working with Texas Parks and Wildlife and the State of Oklahoma the possibility of having a public access for kayaks or canoes may be possible. The group is also working on promoting wildflowers and trails within Fannin County for visitors to come and tour.

Bill Wilson, head of the Business Group provided information on a Risk management seminar the group is having on June 27th at Bonham City hall. The group plans to have seminars that will benefit individuals looking to start a business or that already have one every few months. The goal is to help business owners learn more about various subjects that they might not have otherwise had the time to consider or even know to consider in managing their business.

Lisa Avila, head of the Retirement Committee informed the attendees that the group has been working on getting together information that retirees are interested in before they make the decision to move to a community. Tax Rates, volunteer opportunities, crime rates, housing costs, etc. are all considered and the committee's goal is to have a one-stop place to obtain the information.

The next meeting will take place on September 25, 2014 at the Fannin County Multipurpose Complex.
